Taster Sessions

A follow on from the popular "Raising Children's Self Esteem" Taster course. The SEB Toolkit will cover topics surrounding social emotional and behavioural issues.

Low self image can result from thinking, a confused view of respect, increased levels of stress an aversion to compliments or criticism and lack of assertiveness.

This taster course has been produced for parents who are interested in raising children's confidence.

Strategies learnt will empower parents to help raise their children's self image and self worth.
