- **What will I study in Routes 4 U?**
Interpersonal Communication Skills, Asdan Sport & Fitness Award, Asdan Workright Award, Asdan Environmental Award, Asdan PSHE Award
- **What will the Routes 4 U lessons be like?**
Lessons will challenge the learners, involving team work and individual work. Some practical opportunities and research tasks using ICT skills. There will be group and individual interviews with Total People in preparation for a one day work experience later in year10.
- **How is the course assessed?**
Routes 4 U is continuously assessed through coursework, there are no external exams.
- **How will I be assessed in lessons?**
In the units of work for Asdan the assessments may be practical , for example being assessed on the climbing wall, or by delivering a presentation to a Deputy Head on the History of a Sport
- **Why should I study Routes 4 U?**
Consider Routes 4 U if you may consider a vocational direction at the end of year 11 as there will be a one day work placement and the opportunity to visit Warrington Collegiate to see what vocational courses are offered there post 16.
Learners have said.....' it's good because we get to do different awards.....we get to go out to see the college at Warrington and have a day at work.....we get support on coursework too.
- **What course/career can Routes 4 U lead on to?**
Routes 4 U can lead to entry onto vocational courses at Warrington Collegiate and sometimes apprenticeships from the work placement
- **What are the results like in Routes 4 U?**
Learners have achieved entry to Vocational courses at Warrington Collegiate and some have started apprenticeships within the workplace
